Forum to elaborate proposals to the SG

Consultation on particular issues

Forum for election of representatives to SG

Plenary may submit suggestions for consideration by the SG

SG Chair reports to Plenary



Rules of Participation



- Pre-registration Invitations to nominated invitee only



- » Reimbursement to first 80 representatives from non-for-profit organisations confirming attendance
- » One representative per research centre or database provider shall be reimbursed





Meeting Frequency & Rules of Procedure

- At least one (one-day) meeting per year (possibility of extraordinary meetings)
- ENCePP Secretariat support
- Report by ENCePP SG Chair
- Review of SG terms of reference and mandate at least every two years
- Working Groups
- Participation of Experts
- Consultations and contacts with interested parties
