Highest Authority

Assist Agency in implementation of ENCePP

Define and safeguard ENCePP principles

Decision-making on operational tasks of the network



Specific tasks and duties

- Identification of priority actions
- Approval of work programme
- Oversight of activities
- Adjudicator in case of discrepancies or complaints
- Ongoing review of ENCePP working model and WG structure
- Champion and promote ENCePP

Rules of Procedure

- Commitment to attend (no replacement possible) and active participation
- 4 meetings per year minimum (2 face-to-face, 2 Vitero)
- Quorum: two thirds (i.e. 10 members)
- Decision-making by consensus
 (if consensus not achieved ⇒ recommendations by majority vote)
- Possibility of involvement of co-opted experts
- Establishment of working groups, as appropriate
- Consultation of ENCePP centres
- Report to ENCePP centres after each meeting; report to Plenary by Vice-Chair
- Recommendations for change to terms of reference and mandate
